### Excursion Itinerary:

On Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> August 2017, all Year 3 students will participate in an excursion to the Melbourne Museum, Nicholson Street, Carlton.

Students will be travelling by bus to the venue. During their time at the Museum, they will participate in the 'First Peoples' Self-Guided Trail. Students will also have the opportunity to explore the Melbourne Story gallery, the Forest gallery and the Dinosaur Walk exhibition.

It is important to note that **buses will be departing the school at 9:00am sharp**. Students need to be at school **prior** to this time. The bus is unable to wait for late arrivals.

Students will need to bring their snack, lunch and drink with them on the day in clearly labelled disposable plastic bags. The morning snack and the lunch should be packed in two separate, clearly labelled bags. Only disposable containers etc. should be sent so that they can be thrown away at the venue.

### Educational Purpose of the excursion:
