Excursion Itinerary:

On Friday 1st September, our Year 1 students will be involved in an excursion to the Coal Creek Heritage Village (South Gippsland Highway, Korumburra).

Students will be travelling by bus to the venue. When they arrive at the venue students will be involved in a tour of the village and participate in experiencing what life was like in the past including school, train ride and a trip to the general store.

Students will need to bring their snack, lunch and drink with them on the day in clearly labelled disposable plastic bags. The morning snack and the lunch should be packed in two separate, clearly labelled bags. Only disposable containers etc. should be sent so that they can be thrown away at the venue.
