Incursion Itinerary:

The 'Responsible Pet Ownership' Education program will visit Pakenham Springs Primary School and run three sessions. Students will attend one forty minute session, which focuses on safety in familiar and unfamiliar situations.

The program is run by a trained Pet Educator and their temperament tested dog.

Educational Purpose of the incursion:

This year the Prep students have learnt about being safe in different situations.

The Responsible Pet Program focuses specifically on safety around dogs. It looks at the warning signs given by dogs, the correct way to approach a dog and what to do if approached by an aggressive dog. An interactive web-site also complements this program.

Staff participating in incursion:

Each class teacher and any Learning Support Assistants will be accompanying their students to their session.
